Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP)

- This 3-year plan is how schools set goals for using funds to improve student outcomes.
- Every year staff, families, and students are asked to give input.
- This plan is approved each year by the school board.



Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP)

These are our goals for 21-22 School Year:

Goal #1: Increase Academic Performance

- Measured by: Highly Qualified Teachers and their Assignments, Reading and Math Growth on NWEA, Average Credit Completion, EL Reclassification and Progress on the ELPAC, Graduation Rate

Goal #2: Students Will Gain Skills for College & Career-Readiness

- Measured by: Access to Standards-aligned Materials, Academic Standards aligned to EL Courses, ELA/Math/Science State Assessments, # Enrolled in College Ready Courses, CTE Completion, Access to Broad Coursework, a-g Completion

Goal #3: Increase Student Retention Rate

- Measured by: School Facilities Retention Rate w/ Return to District, Attendance Rate, Dropout Rate, Suspension/Expulsion Rate

Goal #4: Increase Stakeholder Involvement

- Measured by: Parent Events, PAC/ELAC Participation, Parent/Student/Staff Surveys



Re-Enrollment and Master Agreement: New School Year

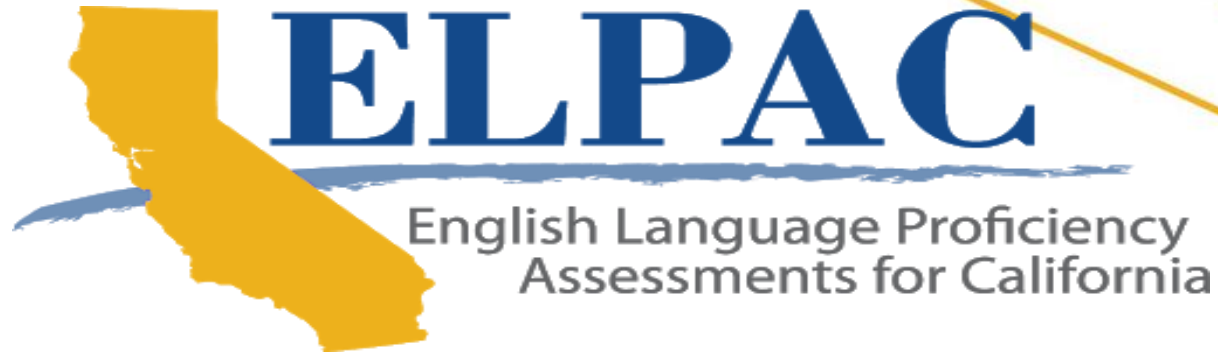
- Students are ***NOT*** automatically enrolled into the new school year. Each student must have a:
 - 1) New Master Agreement
 - 2) Updated Online Registration completedEnrollment forms due by May 31
- First - ***Sign new Master Agreement***
 - Students and parents of minors must sign their student's Master Agreement **by June 30th**
- Second - You will receive an email including a link to complete your (or your student's) ***Online Registration***
 - ***Please confirm your supervising teacher has your correct email address.***



CAASPP/CAST Updates

- Almost all have shown and participated in state testing these areas:
 - Math, ELA, and Science
- Last day to test: May 13th
 - if you have not tested and you are a Junior or a Senior, please contact your supervising teacher immediately





- **ELPAC** is a state mandated test for all English language learners.

Criteria for Reclassification:

1. Student performance on the Reading of the Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA) in a school year. A score of 207 or higher on the NWEA is required.
2. Complete 5 English credits with a grade of C or better in a school year.
3. Overall Score of Level 4 on ELPAC.
