School Improvement and Title 1 Updates (Slide 3)

- School improvement plan- graduation rates
 - Our goal is to graduate at least 85% of our seniors
 - Tutoring Support
- Additional tutoring supports offered to seniors
 - Will be looking to add a tutor to the team in Escondido
 - Increasing regular appointments for seniors working on difficult subjects

Title I Focus Area 1: literacy/Reading Intervention (Slide 4)

SDWIHS recommends expanding student participation in intervention

- Why? Last year, students who participated increased reading lexile by 21%!
- Intervention students YTD: 35 students this school year
- Current gains: As of February 2024, 62% of students have showed growth in reading levels

Title I Focus Area 2: Parent Engagement (Slide 5)

- 62 parents completed the survey last year
- 85% of parents feel encouraged to participate
- A majority of parents strongly agree/agree that our teachers encourage regular attendance and focus on the success of students
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- Additional efforts to increase parent engagement
 - ELAC meetings
 - ELAC President - Blanca
 - Parent teacher conferences- every spring and fall
 - More engaging meetings with more resources
