3. Student Survey Review

- a. Student Survey Data Brink explained a sample of survey results: Most students feel safe at school, and most students feel like they belong at school. Most students are checking in with their teachers more than once a week, and most students feel at least somewhat connected to the adults at school. 97% of students say they have an adult they can go to at school for help if needed. All students are at least slightly likely to recommend our school to others.
- b. Parent Survey Data Brink explained a sample of survey results: 100% of parents say they feel school is safe, 50% of parents feel extremely connected to the school. More than ⅔ of parents say the school always engages them regarding attendance and academic progress. Some parents want more information regarding their student's academic progress and school activities. About 90% of parents are at least somewhat likely to recommend our school to others. About 25% of parents wish they had more input on school activities.
