- III. LCAP Goals & Metrics 2024-2025 SY
  - Goal 1: Increase Academic Progress- *EL outcomes shared. Decrease for EL performance, Growth in Reading and Math scores, as well as credit completion.*
  - Goal 2: College and Career Readiness- *Increase in percentages across all areas mentioned, excluding science. Positive growth overall.*
  - Goal 3: Increase Student Retention- *Attendance rate is down, but increased at City Heights. No suspensions/expulsions.*
  - Goal 4: Increase Parent Engagement- *PAC meeting attendance and overall survey participation increased.*
- IV. School Survey Report
  - Student Responses- *School Climate and Connectedness & Engagement metrics fall between 88-94 percent. 70% of students feel the coursework is challenging.*
  - Parent Responses- *Parents generally feel that their students are safe and are satisfied with their interactions with staff at our school (86-98 percentile range across all metrics).*
  - Staff Responses- *Around 75% feel they can give feedback and feel like the purpose of the school is clear. Nothing scored 100%, but is indicative that there is always room for improvement.*
- V. State Testing Updates
  - a. ELPAC- *96% completion*
  - b. CAASPP- *96% completion*
  - c. CAST- *100% completion*
- VI. Counselor updates:
  - a. Field Trips- *College trips and other field trips made available for students throughout the year.*
  - b. College & Career- *Financial aid still available to all students. The College and Career Readiness course is closing up but remains an option for future enrollment.*
  - c. Social/Emotional- *Referrals available for outside support.*
  - d. Upcoming graduation date & grad deadline- *2 upcoming graduations (8/1 and 10/31). Students/Parents are reminded to be mindful of graduation deadlines.*
