- III. LCAP Goals & Metrics 2024-2025 SY
 - a. Goal 1: Increase Academic Progress
 - Overall, English Learners' progress is 37.5%, which represents moderate growth.
 - Overall reading growth is 95.7%
 - Overall math growth is 95.7%
 - The average student credit completion is 3.13, our goal is 4.0+
 - b. Goal 2: College and Career Readiness
 - The total number of students participating in career readiness courses is as follows:
 - CTE - 162 students
 - JAG - 596 students
 - Professional Skills - 646 students
 - Total number of students participating in Dual Enrollment
 - 32 students
 - Percentage of students identified as prepared
 - 4.6% of students are prepared
 - Percentage of students' growth on statewide assessments
 - ELA - 31%
 - Math - 8%
 - Science - 4%
 - CA Dashboard Academic Performance Indicator ELA and Mathematics Status
 - ELA increased by 26.7 points
 - Math increased by 17.2 points

 - Attendance rate 84.89%

d. Goal 4: Increase Parent Engagement

- A total of 620 parents attended PAC and ELAC Meetings
- Parent Survey Results
 - 25% of all parents participated
 - 100% feel safe
 - 99% feel connected to the school
 - 98% feel engaged and encouraged to participate
- Students' Survey Results
 - 48% of the total students participated
 - 99% feel safe
 - 98% feel connected to the school
 - 99% feel engaged and encouraged to participate

IV. School Survey Report

a. Student Responses

- School climate
 - 91% feel safe at school
 - 88% are satisfied with the amount of time they spend interacting with their teachers
- Connectedness and Engagement
 - 91% have a trusted adult at school they can turn to for help
 - 94% reported that their teacher expects weekly attendance
- Academics
 - 70% feel that the coursework is challenging
 - 88% feel supported by school staff when experiencing learning challenges

b. Parent Responses

- Safety and connection
 - 98% feel that the school is safe
 - 86% feel connected to the school
- Time and interaction
 - 87% are satisfied with the amount of time their child interacts with their teacher(s)
 - 98% feel the school treats them with respect
- Communication
 - 92% feel that school-to-home communication is clear
 - 96% feel like their voice is welcomed and heard
