- Michelle reviewed what our mid-year LCAP report is
 - Increased tutor participation by 177%
 - High credit completion for students who have tutoring appointments
- Betsy reviewed LCAP goals:
 - Increased academic progress
 - Increase student attendance
 - Increase College and career readiness
 - Increase Parent engagement

 - We plan to improve our grade rate by engagement with tutors and providing tracking information of students in their 4th and 5th year
 - What have developed a plan to monitor this

 - Supervising teachers monitor progress towards CSI
 - Tutors work with students to complete credits
